## **PURPOSE**

The purpose of this procedure is to establish the minimum standard for academic progress for students enrolled in curriculum courses at the Technical College of the Lowcountry.

## **PROCEDURE**

- 1. A semester/term and cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 shall be used to determine satisfactory academic standing. Students who fall below this standard will be subject to institutional intervention strategies.
- 2. The Registrar reviews student's academic files and identifies students not making academic progress. Students who fail to earn the required GPA as indicated will be placed on probation during the next term in which they enroll in the college.

Developmental Education courses and courses numbered 100 do not generate quality points and will not be used in determining academic progress.
