

Massage Therapy Program Cost

The TCL Massage Therapy program is a one-year, three-semester (Fall/Spring/Summer), full-time curriculum. Students pay tuition each semester of enrollment in the program prior to the start of the semester by the published payment deadlines, or establish a payment plan prior to the deadline.

Total Cost:	\$5,146.00

Residents of Effingham and Chatham Counties who meet Georgia residency requirements are eligible for in-state tuition (College Non-Service Area) at the Technical College of the Lowcountry.
